

# Proposal to revitalise 3-7 Rangers Road, Neutral Bay

## JULY 2022

Woolworths stores have been part of the Neutral Bay community for many years, and we are planning now for the future. Last month, we lodged a mixed use Planning Proposal to revitalise our site on Rangers Road, Neutral Bay.

Our vision is to improve the shopping and living experience in Neutral Bay. Our plan delivers quality retail, an upgraded supermarket, homes close to shops and services, and a new public plaza shielded from busy Military Road.

We are at the early stages of planning, and our initial plans seek to amend the local environmental plan (LEP). Separate Development Application (DA) approvals would be needed before any work could start.

We are committed to engaging with the local community through the process.

#### Our Planning Proposal lodged with North Sydney Council includes:



An upgraded, full line supermarket tailored to Neutral Bay customers



An outdoor public plaza that connects Yeo Street and Rangers Road



Green landscaping, creating more space for the community to spend time outside



A mix of quality, residential apartments



Around 200 underground community parking spaces, with additional parking for residents



New cafes, restaurants and local services for the community to enjoy.

## **PLANNING PATHWAY**



#### May 2022

Planning Proposal was lodged with North Sydney Council in May 2022, which seeks to amend the local environmental plan (LEP) and set parameters for future plans for the site.

### June – August 2022

Engagement with the community and Council in relation to plans for Neutral Bay Town Centre.

## Mid 2023

Anticipated Council determination of the Planning Proposal. Council will determine whether the Planning Proposal will proceed to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) for further consideration – in what is known as a 'Gateway' determination for approval.

## Mid 2023

Planning proposal expected to be placed on public exhibition, subject to Council decision.

## Late 2023

Woolworths will begin preparing a local Development Application (DA) if the Planning Proposal is supported.
